
## Jill Guest (August 2014)

Gates. My Beasley Connection However goes back to before the chapel was built, in1843 my maternal3x great-grand-father John Beasley lived in Two Gates and rented a field in Cradley upper field belonging

to the estate of George Biggs (tithe map and schedules 1843 Margaret Bradley & Barry Blunt.) This was an arable field from its placement on the map and its size it appears to be the field on which the chapel was built in 1867.



My family connections continue with my Great aunty May (May Andrews) my grannies sister who came to the ladies group here and possibly came to Sunday school as a small girl before the First World War. Her funeral was held at Two Gates Ragged School in January 1997 conducted by Mrs.

Hazel Clifton. Two Gates held a special place in her heart.

I came to various services and events here, but on Mothers Day March 2004, I stood in the pulpit and took the service for the first time in any church, due mainly to Barry's persistence and persuasion. In 2014 ten years later, I again took the Mothers Day service. In those ten years I have taken many
