125th Year Christmas Day Service

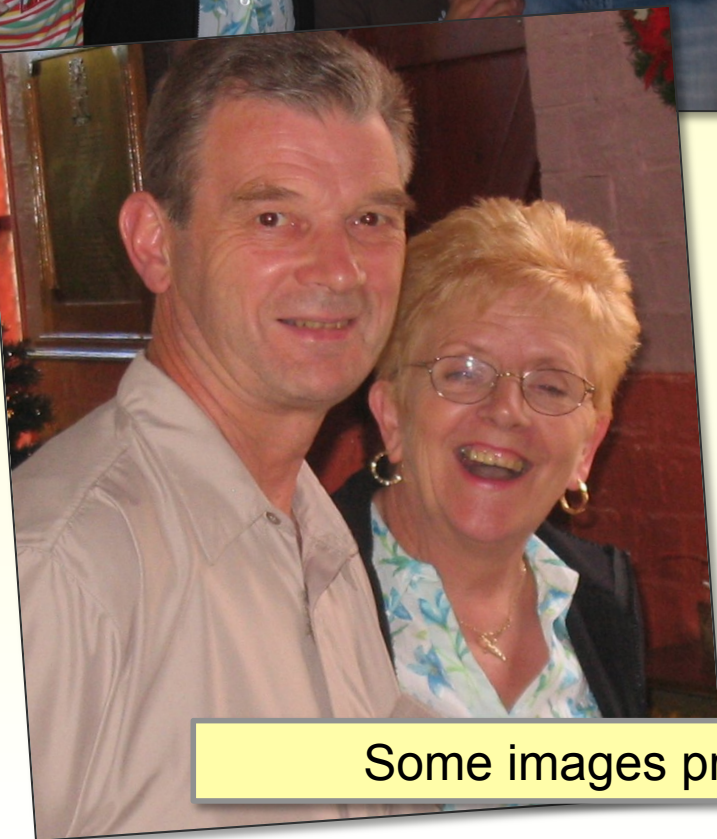
